RULES

1. Students entering horticulture exhibits must be on the official FFA roster.
2. Entries must be entered between 9 am and 12 noon on Monday, July 11, 2011.
3. Entries will be judged after 1:00 pm on Monday, July 11, 2011.
4. Entries will be released on Saturday July 16, 2011. All entries must be picked up between 10 am and 12 noon.
5. All exhibits must be properly labeled to be considered for premiums. Premiums will be paid at time of release. Removing entries early will result in a forfeit of prize money.
6. Premiums will be paid on a Danish system.
 - a. Landscape Design Display - \$50.00
 - b. Potted Flowers/Plants - \$100.00
 - c. Floral Design - \$50.00
7. Exhibitors are encouraged to display entries at the Kentucky State Fair.

LANDSCAPE DESIGN DISPLAY

1. The Display should consist of a scale model of a home, trees, shrubs, walks, patios, etc. The scale model must be constructed on a hard surface of four square feet (2'x2') or less. The landscape design display will count 40% in the judging.
2. A landscape design plan drawn to scale and the same as the model must accompany the display.
 - a. Label all pertinent components directly on the plan, including walks, drives, picnic tables, ponds, etc.
 - b. Put the "KEY" of plants and components directly on the plan page (not on a separate sheet)
 - c. The landscape design plan will count 60% in the judging.
 - d. Vellum paper for the design plan is recommended.
3. Each member may enter only one entry per class.

POTTED FLOWERS/PLANTS

1. Exhibits shall consist of one or more plants individually potted.
2. FFA members may exhibit only one potted plant in each of the listed classes for potted plants.
3. Plants must be properly labeled with the FFA members name and the name of the plant.
4. Potted plants must be grown by the student exhibiting the plant.
5. The plant and pots should be “touched-up” before they are exhibited.
6. Exhibitor must have plant properly identified and classified (by classes listed below) before bringing entry to the fair.

- PP-1 Blooming Houseplants
- PP-2 Cacti/Succulents
- PP-3 Ferns
- PP-4 Ficus
- PP-5 Blooming Annuals
- PP-6 Schefflera
- PP-7 Low Light Foliage Plants
- PP-8 Hanging Baskets other than ferns
- PP-9 High Light Foliage Plants
- PP-10 Any Other Plant
- PP-11 Best Potted Display (multi-variety)

1. The design must be in a single container. The design must be the work of the exhibitor.
2. One entry per class per member
